

# Hoosier Fix 2024 Report

Hoosier Fix is a 501(c)3 Non-Profit that provides free or reduced cost spay/neuter surgeries and vaccinations for dog and cat owners in Marion County, Indiana, and surrounding areas.



## When was Hoosier Fix (HF) created?

HF was created in September 2020 and became a 501(c)(3) in February 2021.

## Why is spay/neuter so important?

Spaying and neutering cats and dogs helps reduce the number of unwanted pets in shelters, lowers taxpayer costs (if publicly funded), and promotes better pet health. It also reduces negative behaviors and cuts down on pet care expenses for owners and rescues/shelters. Our goal is to ensure that every pet stays with their family for life.

## How is HF different from other organizations?

HF provides personalized care to guide clients through every step of the process, from the application to post-surgery follow-up. We understand the apprehension some may feel about having their pet fixed and alleviate these concerns with compassionate, individualized support, ensuring a reassuring and confident experience for every client.

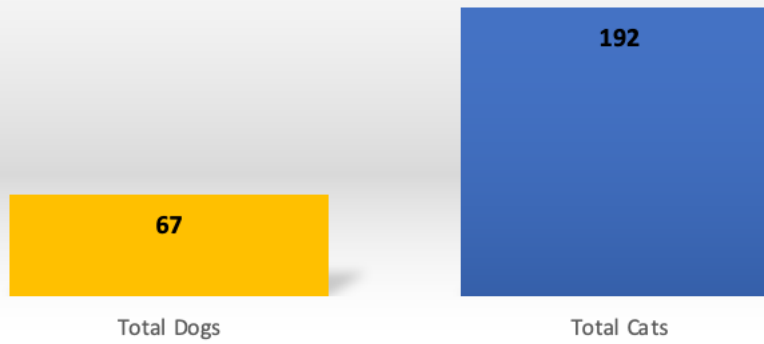
HF is dedicated to removing any obstacles clients may face, offering services like free carriers and transportation to ensure a smooth experience. As a 100% volunteer-run organization, our only expenses are for spay/neuter procedures and vaccinations at IndyHumane's Downtown Clinic (456 N. Holmes Avenue, Indy 46222).

## Important Information

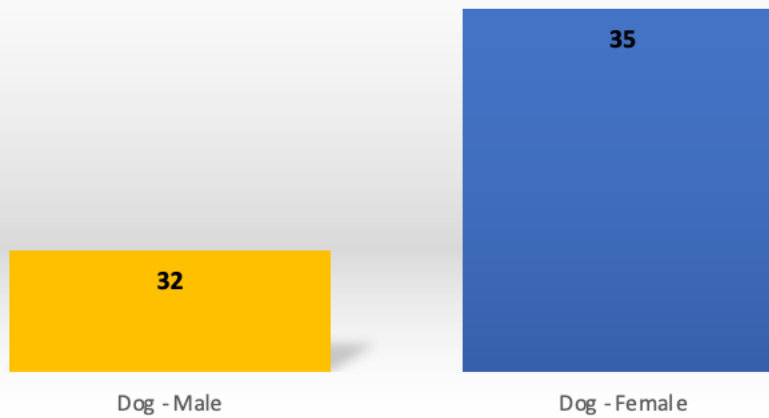
- Since our founding in September 2020, we have coordinated the spay/neuter of over 2,040+ cats and dogs.
- In 2024, we coordinated the spay/neuter of 259 pets – 67 dogs and 192 cats.
- Seventy (70%) percent of our referrals come from previous clients who have told friends or family about our organization.
- 92 of our 2024 clients are primarily renting their living spaces.
- Free transportation to/from IndyHumane was provided for 28 pets in 2024.
- We had 199 pets microchipped in 2024 (20 pets were already chipped).
- Of the 259 pets fixed in 2024, we had vaccinations given to 244 of them. These pets received age-appropriate boosters and rabies vaccines.
- We partner with pet related organizations in 3 counties – Johnson, Marion & Morgan.

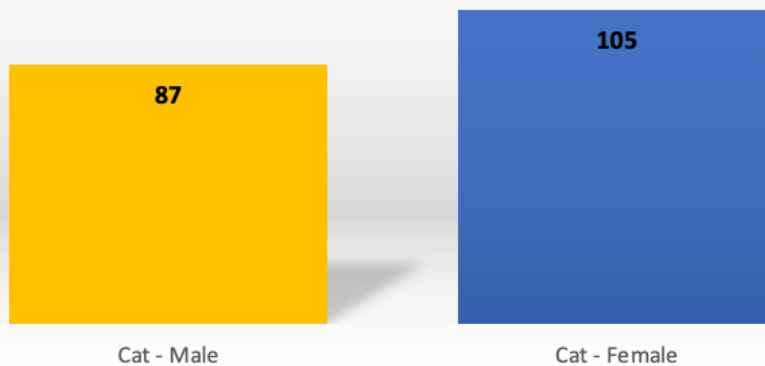
## Dogs and Cats



## Dogs - Male/Female

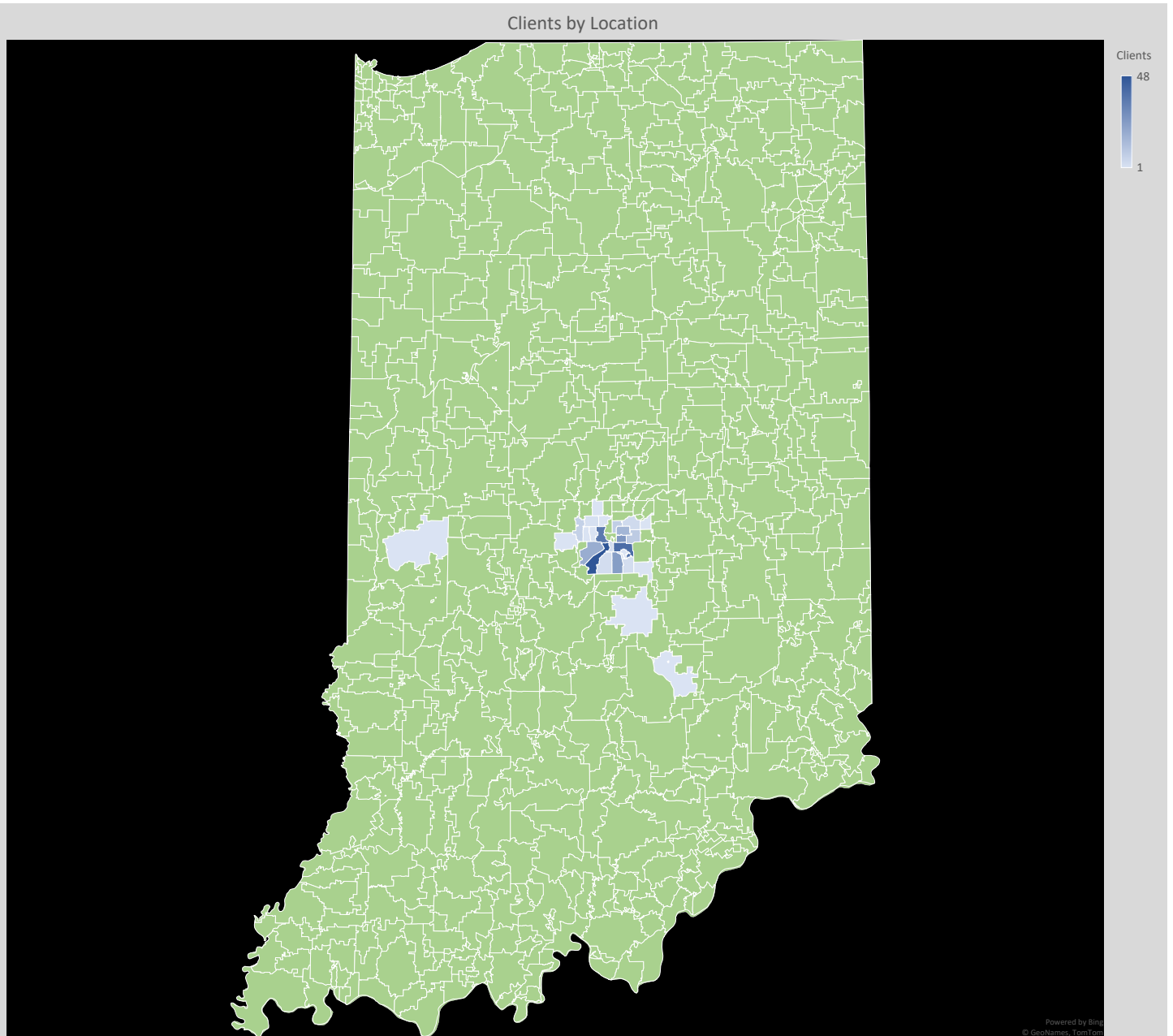


## Cats - Male/Female

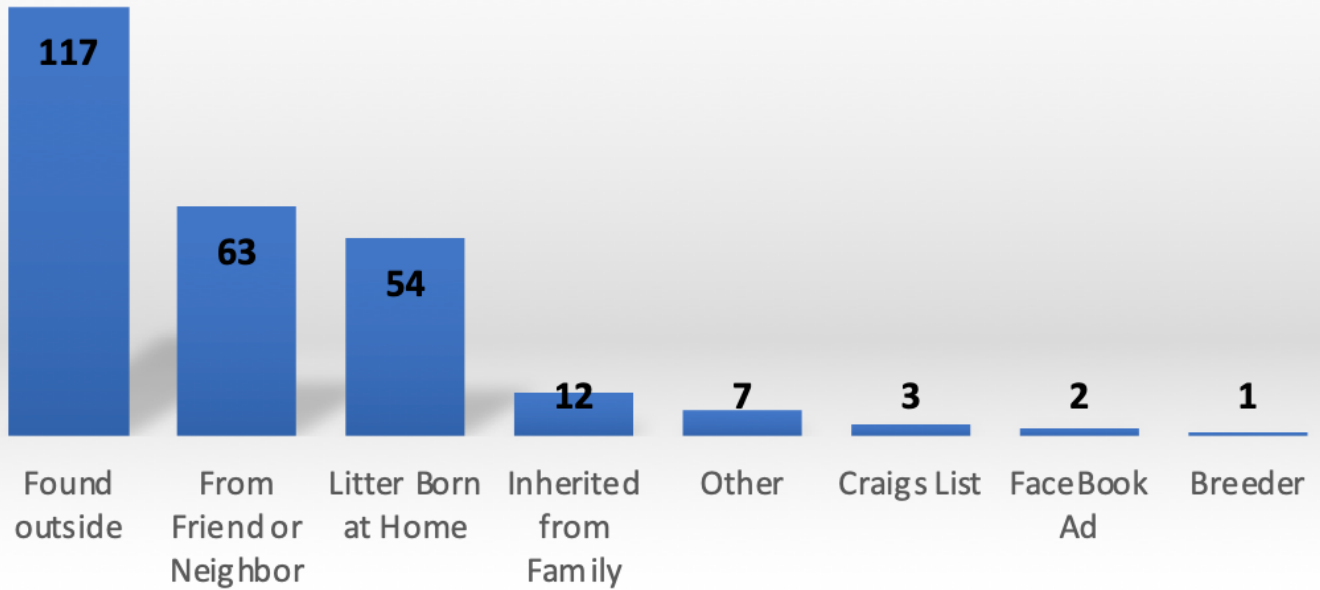


Top Zip Codes Impacted for 2024  
(Reached **26** Zip Codes in Indiana Overall)

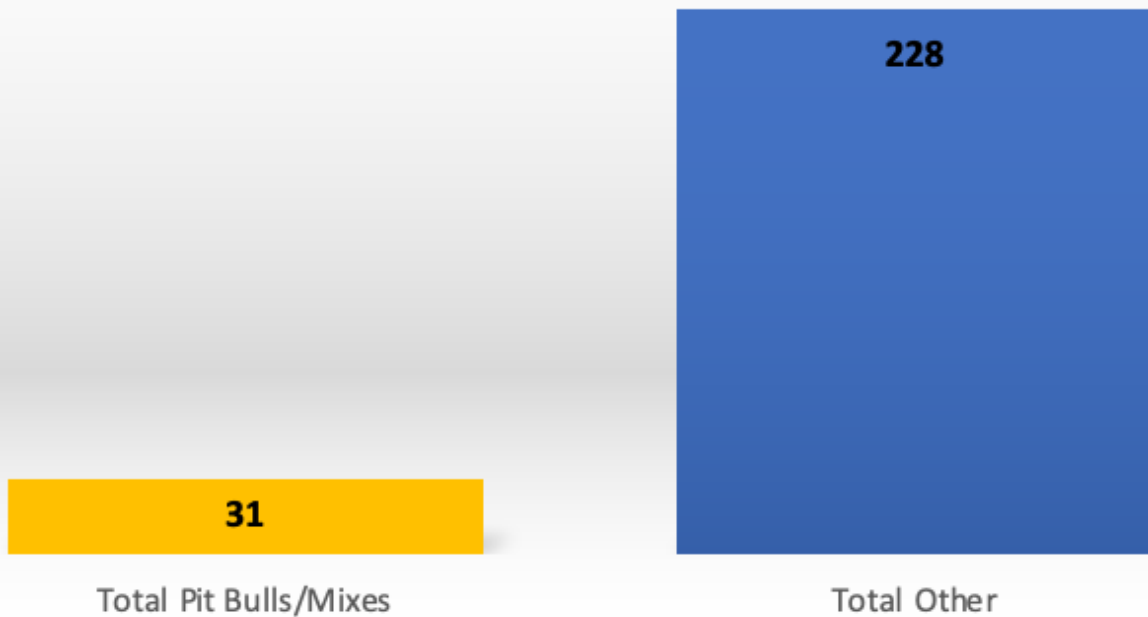

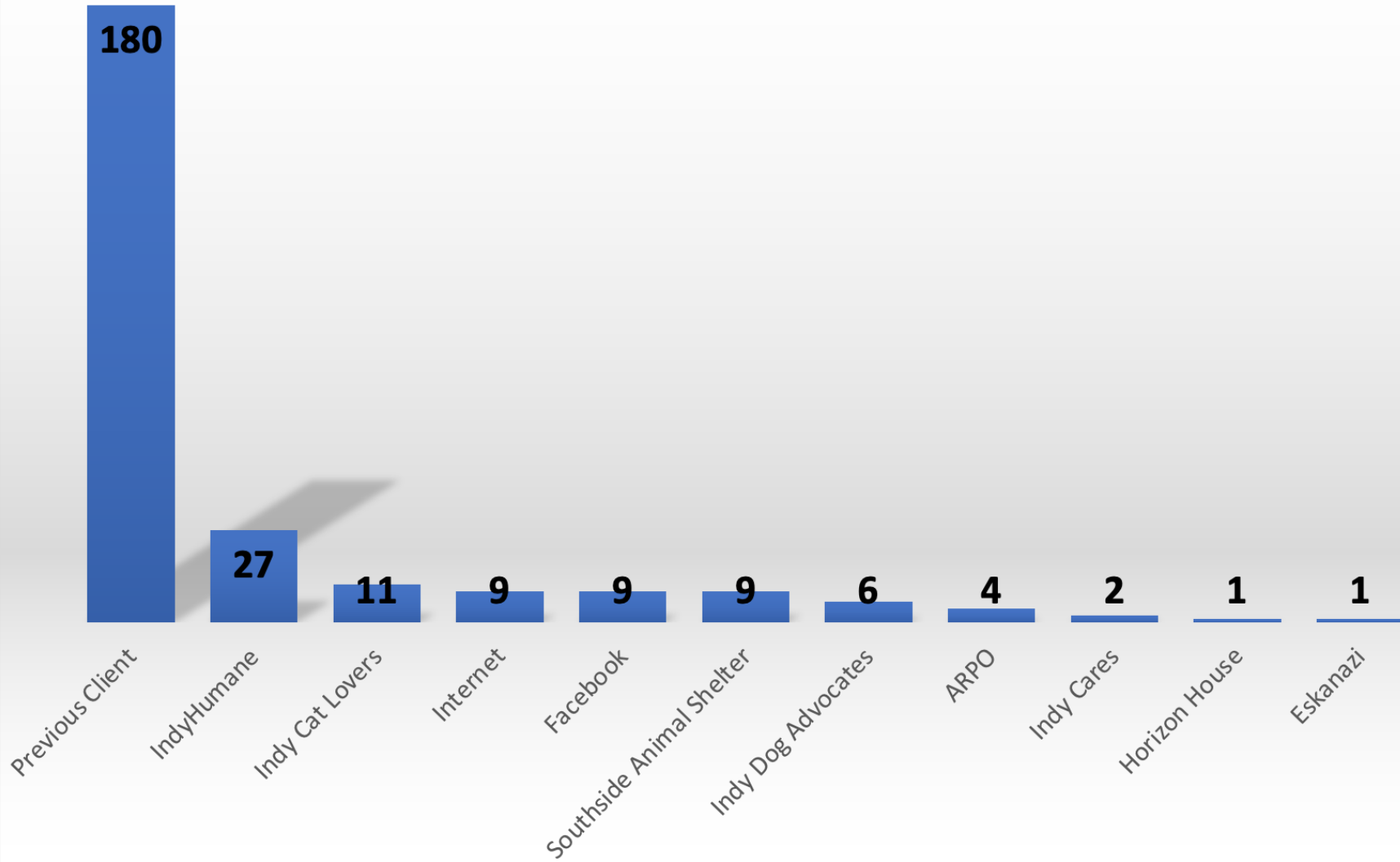
## How Pets Were Acquired
